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I. Form of Contract

LUMP-SUM

This CONTRACT (hereinafter called the "Contract") is made the **20** th day of the month of September, 2017, between, on the one hand, **the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, National Implementation Office (MAFF-NIO)** (hereinafter called the "Client") and, on the other hand, **Nuppun Institute for Economic Research** (hereinafter called the "Consultant").

WHEREAS

- (a) the Client has requested the Consultant to provide certain consulting services as defined in this Contract (hereinafter called the "Services");
- (b) the Consultant, having represented to the Client that it has the required professional skills, expertise and technical resources, has agreed to provide the Services on the terms and conditions set forth in this Contract;
- (c) The Ministry of Economy and Finance, through the Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC), has received a loan from the Asian Development (ADB), and grants from the Global Agriculture and Food Security Program (GAFSP) and the Strategic Climate Fund (SCF) to implement the Climate Resilient Rice Commercialization Sector Development Program (Rice-SDP). The Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, an implementing agency of the Project, intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this financing to eligible payments under this Contract, it being understood that (i) payments by the Bank will be made only at the request of the Client and upon approval by the Bank; (ii) such payments will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the grant/loan agreement, including prohibitions of withdrawal from the grant/loan account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of the Bank, is prohibited by the decision of the United Nations Security council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations]; and (iii) no party other than the Client shall derive any rights from the grant/loan agreement or have any claim to the grant/loan proceeds;

NOW THEREFORE the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:
